

Sermon Notes:

HYMN OF THE MONTH...For February: 409 - "Hail, O Source of Every Blessing" The author of our hymn of the month is Basil Woodd. He was born at Richmond in Surrey on August 5, 1760. The influences of his home and of his widowed mother were most salutary, and produced the best results. As a boy, he studied under the Rev. T. Clarke of Chesham Bois, and at seventeen, he entered Trinity College, Oxford. Taking Holy Orders in 1783, he was chosen lecturer of St. Peter's Cornhill in 1784; morning preacher at Bentinck Chapel, Marylebone, in 1785; and Rector of Drayton Beauchamp, Buckinghamshire, in 1808. Bentinck Chapel is a proprietary chapel; he purchased the lease in 1793 and held the Incumbency, together with the Rectory of Drayton, from 1808 to his death on April 12, 1831. He took a deep interest in the great religious societies and in the anti-slavery movement. His prose works were not numerous or important. He is associated with hymnody; the best known is "Hail, Thou Source of Every Blessing."


