HYMN OF THE MONTH...For May: #466 - Christ Has Arisen, Alleluia. Bernard Kyamanywa (1938–2021), author of Christ Has Arisen, Alleluia (LSB 466), was a Lutheran pastor and bishop in Tanzania. Orphaned as a child, he was raised by a German deaconess at the Lutheran Bethel Mission, where he received both his early education and Christian formation. Trained first as a teacher and later in theology at the Lutheran Theological College in Makumira, Kyamanywa wrote Mfurahini, Haleluya in 1966 while still a seminary student. The hymn was composed in the African call-and-response tradition, rooted in the joyful Easter faith of his Haya people. Kyamanywa also helped translate the Bible into the Haya language and devoted his life to pastoral ministry and church leadership. His hymn continues to bring the vibrant proclamation of Christ's resurrection to the global Church.

THE PASCHALLANDIE... Was added to the chance fall Grace this basier! A Paschal

that represents the light of Christ, risen from the dead, snining in the darkness. It is first lit during the Easter Vigil (Saturday evening) symbolizing Christ's triumph over death and his presence among his people. Then incomposit the Easter season the easter season, it is used at papusms - signifying that the baptized are joined to the light of Christ - and at funerals - reminding us that those who die in Christ live with Him eternally. Its presence is a visual proclamation of the resurrection and the life we have in Him.
